The Trust is the largest provider of primary health care services in the Te Hiku (Far North) region and offers effective and accessible primary health care to the Far North community focusing in particular on the high needs of our Māori community.

The Trust Board comprises seven trustees, which includes the two community representatives. Our trustees have a collegial approach and are very supportive of the Chief Executive Officer and employees of the Trust.

The new trustees should be enthusiastic about accessibility and will demonstrate the following personal skills – a team player, strong communication skills, integrity, and a positive and constructive manner that is sensitive to differing approaches. Trustees should also bring experience, attributes or skills in one or more of the following areas: contemporary and/or traditional health skills, business experience, management experience, networking skills, contracting skills, coordination skills, Māori process skills, governance skills and recognition of prior learning.

The trustee positions are voluntary, but travel and meeting expenses are reimbursed. The Te Hauora O Te Hiku O Te Ika Trust board meets bi-monthly in Kaitaia.
